Course Description:

This course is a full immersion into the Silicon Valley Innovation Ecosystem bringing together the determination and professionalism of its entrepreneurs and the sophistication of its investors. The content will cover both sides of what makes that ecosystem work, entrepreneurship and investing, and the mutualism that exists here.

The class is based on innovation, entrepreneurship, and investor frameworks. Students will work in teams to complete both an entrepreneurial pitch and an investment memo. The pitches will be used to illustrate the nature of the commitment an entrepreneur makes at the start of a new company. Your investment decision memo will help you understand the strategy behind a range of investor options. These two experiences will cement the overall learning from the content, the visits, and the speakers. You will close with an opportunity to "design your life" based on those experiences.

Expectations:

This is a two-unit course. We have structured the work to be done inside, and outside the class accordingly. We expect that *each of you will prepare for and attend <u>all</u> of the sessions and will participate fully with your teammates in in-class exercises. You are required to <i>be present for all your assigned sessions* both because being present is the only way you will engage with and learn the materials, and because your team members will depend on your contribution to each exercise for their learning as well. Your participation grade will be based on your *on-time arrival to and participation in all assigned sessions*. Missed sessions may lead to an incomplete or failing grade.

Reading Materials:

Readings will be assigned electronically through our learning management system bCourses. The required readings before class will set up the exercises we will do during



our time together. We strive to have you interacting with one another as much as possible, and will limit lecture time accordingly. There is no textbook but we will make several recommendations for related books.

Grading:

Your course grade will be determined as follows:

- 15% Individual pre-class assignments
- 60% Team deliverables
- 25% Individual contribution and reflection paper
